Enjoy three hours of unlimited access to aisles of Australia's best wines, with tickets on sale today for the Royal Queensland Food and Wine Show's (RQFWS) Grape Grazing by Night in July.

Queensland's premier wine tasting event gives the public the rare chance to sample more than 1,500 drops, including the Royal Queensland Wine Show (RQWS) medal-winners and new vintage of season.

Guests can also indulge in Australia's best beef, lamb, cheese and ice cream, including this year's RQFWS Grand Champion dark chocolate lemon gelato from Milani Minus Eight Degrees in Sunnybank and Mildfield Meat International's Union Station lamb from Warrnambool.

More than 900 people are expected to attend the sixth Grape Grazing by Night, with the last three events a sell-out.

The popular event will take place at the Brisbane Showgrounds on Friday 9 July from 5.30pm. Tickets are now on sale at www.grapegrazingbynight.com.au for \$95 each. A special group discount rate of \$85 is also available.

The RQWS is the first capital city wine show of the season and the first to judge the 2021 vintage in Australia. It aims to give wineries exposure by helping to promote the nation's diverse growing regions, the winemakers and their exceptional drops.
