## IMPORTANT DATES & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHEN DO ENTRIES CLOSE?

Friday 31 May 2024.

### WHEN ARE DELIVERIES?

Products to be judged must be delivered to the Brisbane Showgrounds from Monday 17 June to Friday 21 June between 8:30am and 4pm.

### WHEN IS JUDGING?

Judging will commence on Monday 1 July, with trophy judging taking place on Thursday 4 July.

### WHEN ARE THE WINNERS ANNOUNCED?

Trophy winners will be announced, and the results catalogue published online on Friday 12 July 2024.

## ENTERING

### HOW MUCH IS IT TO ENTER?

\$110 per entry (excluding GST)

### HOW DO I ENTER?

Online via the competition portal - click here to access the link. Exhibitors will be required to make a new account or log in to a pre-existing account to submit entries.

### HOW DO I KNOW WHICH CLASS TO ENTER?

Our online entry system will be able to filter the classes that your wine is eligible to enter, based on the information you input. For example, if you have a 2019 Shiraz, you will only be given the option to enter the 2019 Shiraz class. ## DELIVERY OF ENTRIES

### WHERE DO I DELIVER MY EXHIBIT TO?

Brisbane Showgrounds - Upper Exhibition Building

Access off Gregory Terrace via the ramp, Bowen Hills, 4006

Drivers can proceed up the ramp and wait for further instructions from RQA staff.

### DO I NEED TO ACCOMPANY ANYTHING WITH MY DELIVERY?

Each bottle of wine should have a competition label adhered to the front. There is no specific area the label should be stuck, but effort should be made to avoid the wine's label.

### I HAVE NOT RECEIVED THE LABELS. WHAT DO I DO?

### HOW MANY WINE BOTTLES DO I NEED TO DELIVER?

This depends on what type of wine you have entered. Please refer to the delivery section on page nine of the competition schedule. The most common amount is 6 x 750ml bottles or equivalent to 4.5 litres.
